- ▶ Held one general meeting so far, >80 people attended. Planning on ~ one a month
- ▶ Website is in work
- ▶ We have subteams, just getting organized, for:
 - ▶ Congressional liaisons (Senators, Congressmen); certain targeted Republicans (Issa, Walters, Rohrabacher); liaisons to local Democratic clubs, progressive groups, other Indivisible groups, Communications; news monitoring, tech/inclusion help, local city politics, fundraisers, Chambers of Commerce, Group coordination.
- ▶ We are nearly all political neophytes. Will benefit from working with experienced people such as Democratic Clubs
